The sculptures will be built on-site on the ground floor of **555 Legget Drive Tuesday, May 7th** and will remain on display until the morning of **Thursday, May 9th**. Once disassembled, the goods used to build the sculptures will be donated to the Kanata Food Cupboard. Not only is this a great team-building event, but by participating you will be supporting a local charity and your community.

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Rules and Regulations

With the aim of keeping everyone safe and promoting fair competition, the following rules and regulations apply to all participants:

- Each team will be required to provide a sketch or computer rendering of their design, along with a name for the sculpture, no later than Tuesday, April 30th 2019.
- Sculptures will each be allocated a 10' x 10' x 10' space - this is the maximum size allowed.
- Only unopened non-perishable food or toiletry items are permitted.
- Sculptures cannot include glass bottles of any kind
- Sculptures cannot include alcoholic products of any kind
- Sculptures must be structurally self-supporting. Non-permanent adhesives as well as guides made of 1/4" plexiglass, cardboard, plywood, masonite etc. are permitted as long as they are not visible / there is minimal visibility.
- A maximum of 5 builders will be permitted in each build site at a time. Builders can be swapped out as needed.

Itinerary

Tuesday, May 7th 9:00am to 12:00pm

Build time! Drop off of cans and general setup can begin as early as 8:00am, but the construction of the sculptures will not begin until after opening remarks just before 9:00am. At your own risk, you may deliver your building materials the night before anytime between 4:00pm and 7:00pm.

Tuesday, May 7th 12:00pm to 1:00pm

The jury will circulate and evaluate the sculptures. Awards will be announced by 1:00pm. In the meantime, KRP will provide a lunch to all the hungry builders.

Thursday, May 9th 9:00am to 12:00pm

Deconstruction. The Kanata Food Cupboard will provide boxes to place food / toiletry items in. Each team is responsible for disassembling their structures / any associated materials. The Kanata Food Cupboard will bring the boxes full of donation items back to their warehouse for sorting.
